Course Name: Bachelor of Science (First Semester)

1. Eligibility Criteria:

For the purpose of admission, a candidate shall have passed Std. 12 (or equivalent) Science from government recognized board with English as one of the subjects OR English as medium of instruction.

Provisional Eligibility Certificate is required for the candidates qualifying from other than (i) Gujarat board or (ii) NIOS board or (iii) Central boards schools located in Gujarat.

2. Reservation of Seats:

- Reservation of seats shall be as per the guidelines of Government of Gujarat from time to time, provided the candidate produces valid certificate(s) duly signed by competent authority empowered by the Government of Gujarat.
- The candidate mentioned in 2(a) has to submit the valid certificate(s) within the stipulated time, failing to which, the admission applications shall be considered under unreserved category.
- If any of the reserved seats remains vacant then such a seat will be made available to the candidates of open category.

3. Preparation of Merit:

- For all the eligible candidates (mentioned in 1), merit shall be prepared as and when required on the basis of percentage of marks obtained (grand total) in qualifying examination.
- In case of equal merit marks, following sequences shall be followed:
 - Marks obtained in Science subjects in qualifying examination. If marks obtained in Science subjects are also the same, the percentage marks of 10th standard examination shall be taken into consideration.
 - Aggregate marks of SSC Examination or equivalent examination
 - Date of Birth (Age)

4. Process of Admission:

- The announcement of commencement of admission procedures shall be done by (i) advertisement for admission in the newspapers widely circulated in the university area and/or (ii) website (iii) University and institute notice board (iv) any such other means such as social media

platforms. Such advertisements should include the detailed admission schedule.

- b. A candidate seeking admission shall have to apply as per the instructions/guidelines mentioned in the advertisement for admission.
- c. The institute shall prepare merit list of all eligible candidates after due verification of relevant documents as and when required.
- d. The merit list shall be displayed on the website/notice-board of Institute/University if required.
- e. All supplementary/additional details pertaining to admission procedure (other than mentioned in the advertisement for admission) shall be announced on the website/notice-board of Institute/University.
- f. Upon allotment of admission, the admissions shall be treated as confirmed/secured only after (i) Payment of applicable fees AND (ii) verification of all the original documents, within stipulated time period. Failing to which the admissions shall be considered as cancelled.
- g. The candidates shall have to submit documents as mentioned in the point no. 6.
- h. For the vacant seats after the end of admission procedure, institute may fill the same by following the standard procedure of the university.

5. Fees:

- a. A candidate who gets admission shall have to pay the fees, determined by the University.
- b. If a student applies for cancellation of the admission before commencement of the semester, the entire fees shall be refunded.
- c. If a student applies for admission cancellation after commencement of the semester and within one month of time, the fees shall be refunded after deducting 15% of total fees paid, as administrative charges.
- d. If a student applies for admission cancellation after one month and up to two months of commencement of the semester, the fees shall be refunded after deducting 50% of total fees paid, as administrative charges.
- e. The students are not entitled to get any refund for the current term after issuance of enrolment number by the University.

Course Name: Master of Science

1. Eligibility Criteria:

- a. For the purpose of admission, a candidate shall have passed Bachelor of Science (B. Sc.) from government recognized university with subjects shown in the below table.
- b. Migration certificate is required for the candidates qualifying from other than Gokul Global University.

Course Name: Post Graduate Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (PGDMLT)

- a. For the purpose of admission, a candidate shall have passed the qualifying examination of B. Sc. In Botany/Biochemistry/ Biotechnology/ Chemistry/ Environmental Science/ Microbiology / Zoology or such relevant subjects from the UGC recognized university.
- b. Migration Certificate shall be required for the candidates before registration.
