Ancient Indian History

Prehistoric Period: Paleolithic, Neolithic cultures, Indus Valley Civilization. Vedic Period: Society, economy, polity, religion. Mauryan Empire: Administration, Ashoka's Dhamma. Gupta Period: Society, economy, art, and science.

Medieval Indian History

Early Medieval India: Cholas, Palas, Rajputs, agrarian structures. Delhi Sultanate: Administration, economy, Sufi and Bhakti movements. Mughal Empire: Mansabdari system, Mughal architecture, trade. Regional States: Marathas, Sikhs, Deccan Sultanates.
