This program was lauded by all faculty members for its educational depth and informative nature, contributing significantly to their scholarly pursuits and academic growth.





Report on an expert talk on "Accreditation and Assessment" Process

Resource Person: Prof. (Dr.) Tejal Shah Date: July 23, 2022

Under the auspices of Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Gokul Global University, an expert talk on Accreditation and Assessment Process has been arranged on July 23, 2022 in the seminar hall of Electrical Engineering Department of Hansaba College of Engineering and Technology. Dr. Tejal Shah, Head, Pharmaceutics and Pharmaceutical Technology Department, Institute of Pharmacy, and IQAC Co-ordinator, Nirma University, Ahmedabad have been invited to deliver the talk on A & A process.

In her more than two hours of session, Dr. Shah started with the importance of NAAC accreditation and the involvement of each and every staff of the university for the preparation of the accreditation process. According to her, in total 115 templates are to be filled up and submitted to the NAAC office. She was of the opinion that when the change in syllabus is proposed, it should be change in the course and not only in the content. She reminded the requirements of documents for every activity carried out in and outside of the university including geo tagged photographs. For e.g if the University is claiming that they did green audit, it is to be supported with the certificate of it which is supposed to be obtained from an external agency. Each and every submitted document shall be signed by the Registrar of the University. For uploading the documents, if there are size issues, there are ways to submit it such as submission of link for the information form university website and so on. She emphasized on referring the latest NAAC manual before submitting the information as there are changes made at regular intervals and it is advisable to use the latest format for the submission of information. Information related to Recruiters, Alumni and Placement is again very important. The University shall have registered alumni portal for the registration. Placement data shall always be provided with the information of package too. The NAAC office has access to the data submitted to AISHE office. Hence, there shall not be mismatch in the information submitted to AISHE and to NAAC otherwise it may create an issue. The role of IQAC is very crucial in the entire A & A process.

Recently Nirma University completed their third cycle of A & A process and they got A grade. Out of total 7 criteria of NAAC, highest weightage is of criteria No. 3 i.e. Research, Consultancy and Extension criteria that carry 250 marks. According to her, apart from obtaining good score in other criteria, a total of 180 marks are required for A grade and 225 marks are required for A+ grade out of 250 marks of criteria 3. She also pointed out the importance of Institutional distinctiveness, two best practices and the student's satisfaction survey. 64 teaching staff members took the advantage of this expert session. Dr. Akil Ali Saiyed, Pro-Vice Chancellor accorded floral welcome while the Registrar Dr. H. C. Rajput felicitated Dr. Shah with a memento.


