2. Increased awareness of best practices for quality assurance in higher education.



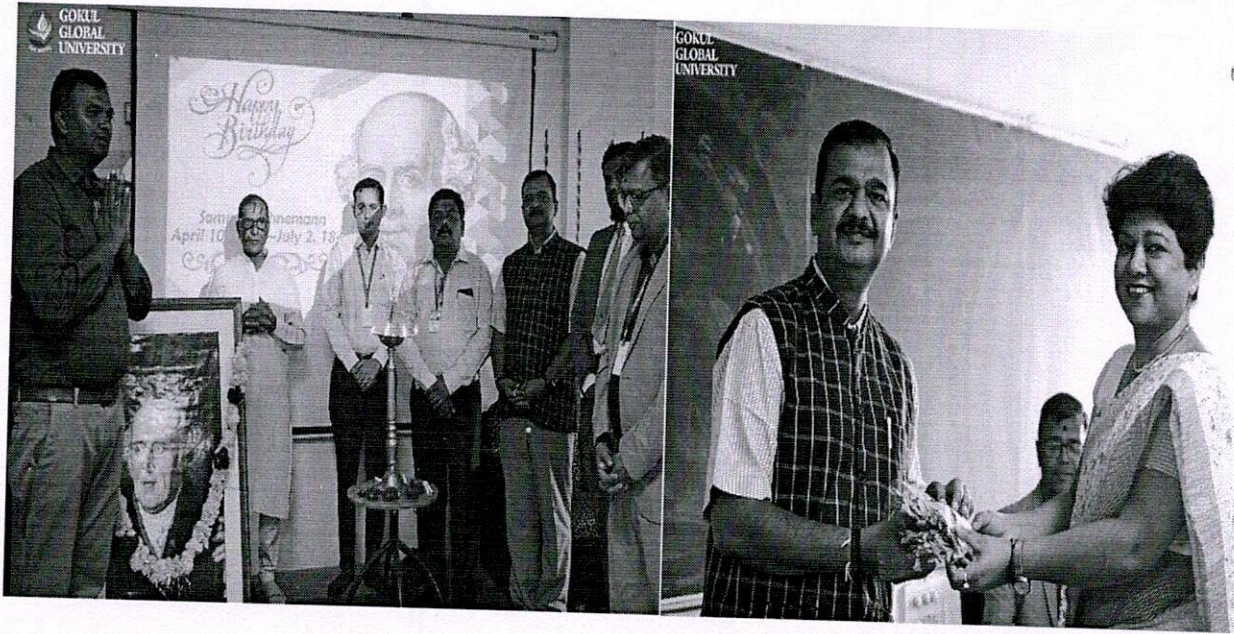


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3. Strengthened collaboration among faculty, administration, and students in the pursuit of quality education.

4. **Commitment to Continuous Improvement:**

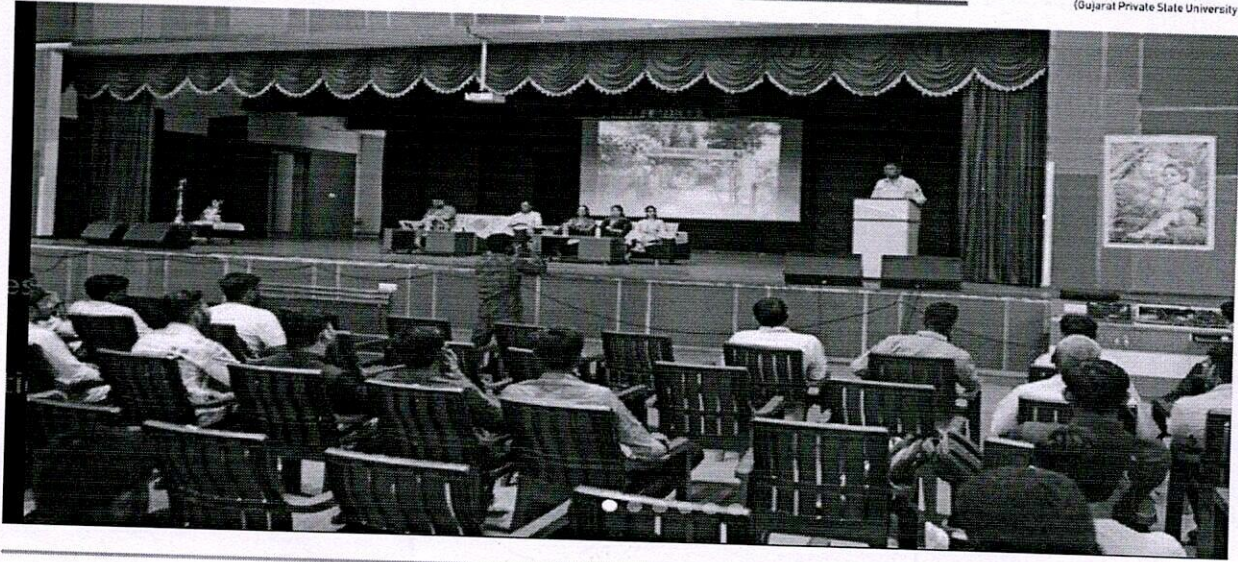
The meeting concluded with a renewed commitment from all attendees to enhance their contributions towards meeting NAAC standards and continuously improving the quality of education at Gokul Global University.

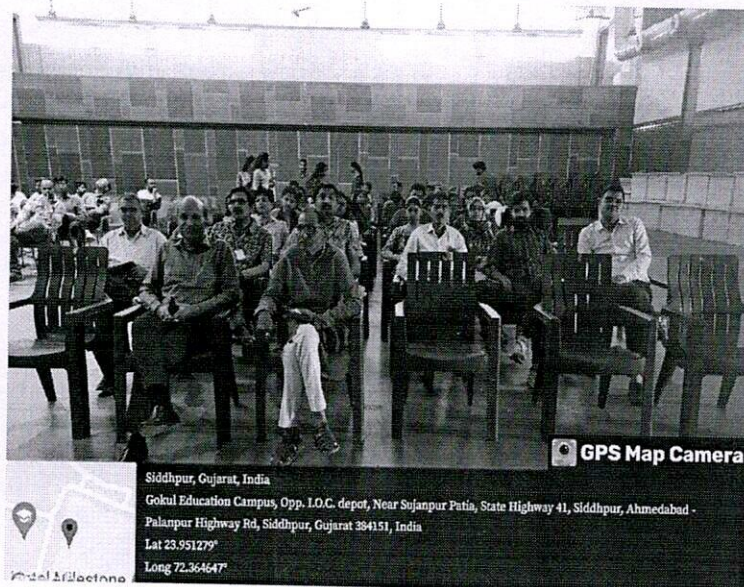
