Event Report




Figure 1 Faculty delivering lecture on code of conduct

- Encourage a culture of respect, collaboration, and responsible behavior within the department.

3. Program Structure

The awareness program is structured as follows:

- Opening Session: The opening session introduces students to the program's agenda, and the
 importance of the code of conduct in academic and professional settings is highlighted. The
 Head of the Department and senior faculty members typically address the students,
 emphasizing the significance of ethical behavior.
- Keynote Lectures: Experts from academia and industry are invited to deliver keynote speeches. These speakers focus on topics such as professional ethics, corporate responsibility, and the long-term implications of following or violating ethical standards in engineering practice.
- Workshops and Interactive Sessions: Hands-on workshops and interactive discussions are
 conducted where students actively engage in case studies on real-life ethical dilemmas faced by
 engineers. These sessions focus on building decision-making skills when confronted with
 ethical challenges.
- Discussion on Academic Integrity: This session focuses on educating students about the
 university's policies on plagiarism, cheating, and other forms of academic dishonesty. Students
 are made aware of the consequences of such misconduct and the importance of upholding
 academic integrity.
- Panel Discussion: A panel of faculty members, student representatives, and industry experts
 holds a discussion on the importance of maintaining professional decorum both within the
 university and in industrial settings. Students have the opportunity to ask questions and seek
 clarification on various aspects of the code of conduct.
- Assessment and Feedback: At the end of the program, students participate in a quiz or assessment that evaluates their understanding of the code of conduct. Additionally, feedback is collected from the participants to improve future awareness programs.

4. Participation

The program is mandatory for engineering students, from first-year to final-year students. Faculty members also actively participate, fostering an environment of mutual respect and shared responsibility in upholding the code of conduct.

5. Key Areas Covered

The key areas covered during the program include:

- Professional Conduct: Emphasizing punctuality, discipline, and respect for peers and faculty.
- Academic Integrity: Understanding the consequences of cheating, plagiarism, and unauthorized collaborations.
- Use of Laboratory Equipment: Ensuring students follow safety guidelines and ethical practices when working in mechanical labs.
- Respect for Diversity: Promoting inclusivity and respectful behavior toward all students, regardless of background.
- Responsible Use of Technology: Highlighting the importance of using technological resources responsibly and ethically.

6. Outcomes and Impact

The awareness program has shown significant positive outcomes:

- Increased Awareness: Students display a greater understanding of the institution's code of conduct, particularly concerning academic integrity and professional ethics.
- Reduction in Misconduct: A noticeable decline in cases of plagiarism and cheating has been observed over the past year.
- Enhanced Professionalism: Students demonstrate more professional behavior during internships, industrial visits, and academic projects, as evidenced by feedback from industry partners.
- Collaborative Environment: The program fosters a collaborative and respectful environment within the department, enhancing peer relationships and faculty-student interactions.

7. Challenges and Recommendations

While the program has been successful, a few challenges were identified:

- Student Engagement: Some students find it difficult to engage with the content, particularly
 those in the early years of study. More interactive and relatable case studies could improve
 engagement.
- Continuity: One-time annual sessions may not be sufficient to sustain ethical awareness. It is recommended that regular follow-up sessions or refresher courses be introduced throughout the academic year.

8. Conclusion

The Annual Awareness Program on the Code of Conduct for Mechanical Engineering students plays a crucial role in shaping the ethical and professional behavior of future engineers. By continuously evolving the program and addressing challenges, the Mechanical Engineering Department ensures that students are well-prepared to meet the ethical demands of their profession.
